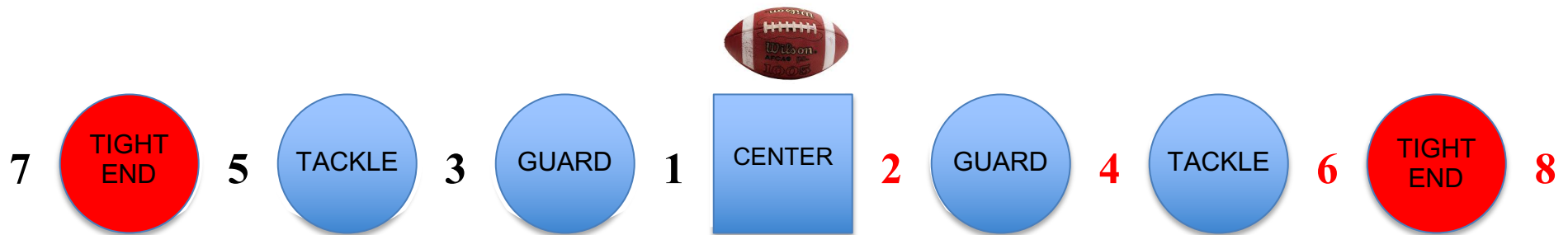


OFFENSE

(Offense is when our team has the ball)



- The diagram above illustrates how we number our offensive holes. On offense we call plays by telling the ball carrier which hole to run the ball through. It is important for all players on offense to understand the numbering system.

- Holes to the **RIGHT** of the **CENTER** position are even numbers (**2,4,6, and 8**).

- Holes to the **LEFT** of the **CENTER** position are odd numbers (**1,3,5, and 7**).

EXAMPLE: If the **RUNNING BACK** is running the ball through the 4-hole, he would run the ball between the **GUARD** and the **TACKLE** on the Right side of the **CENTER**. The **GUARD** and **TACKLE** would be responsible to block any defenders away from the hole, to clear a path for the ball carrier.
